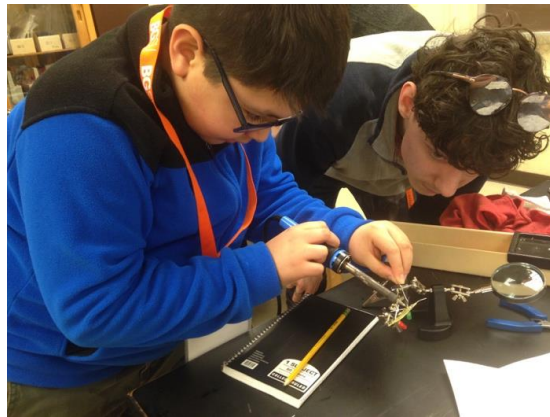


## Registration Opens for Kids' Tech University@BGSU

Enroll your child for the 9<sup>th</sup> season of our science outreach program for children on the BGSU campus. [Kids' Tech University](#) is designed to spark children's interest in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics by having a scientist talk to them about their work, while giving the children opportunities to ask lots of questions. In the afternoon session the children explore scientific concepts guided by mentors in a university teaching lab.

This four-session "university experience" begins Saturday, Feb. 15, and ends Saturday, April 18 and is open to students who live within a one-hour driving distance of BGSU. To participate, children must be 9-12 years old as of Sept. 30, 2019. Each of the four Saturday programs starts off with a talk by our invited speaker in one of our large lecture theaters. Then the children go to one of the BGSU residential cafeterias to eat lunch with their parents and volunteers. The afternoon sessions feature a series of hands-on activities related to the program theme that are directed by professors, students, and community professionals.
