Info for New Families (& good reminders for the rest of us)

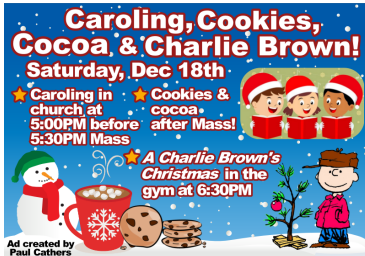
