From the Principal:

The Ohio Department of Health sent a memo to local health departments yesterday which shifts the focus away from universal contact tracing to other strategies. As a result, we will no longer be identifying, notifying or reporting close contacts except in the case of an outbreak or cluster of cases. Additional details will be coming next week and we will share them with you, but this does not indicate that the pandemic has ended, but rather that the exposure is so widespread that this particular strategy is no longer effective.

The guidance for Mask to Stay and Test to Play has not changed and as always we encourage you to reach out to Mrs. Kolbe or myself if you have any questions about those. The most important factor as we move into this new phase of the pandemic is that, as always, students and staff who have symptoms must stay home from school.

At this time, we will continue to notify you if there is a positive case in your child's classroom and to share the school wide numbers in the covid update of the schoolgram each week. As you can see, our case numbers have declined as rapidly as they climbed. Thank you for your diligence and cooperation as we continue to work together to keep kids healthy and in school!

COVID-19 UPDATE

We currently have 2 positive students and 2 students quarantined at home for exposure outside of school. We also have 14 students who are "mask to stay" at this point in time. This means they have a known exposure, but are fully vaccinated or their exposure happened at school or CYO. This also includes individuals who previously tested positive and have completed their initial period of isolation. These individuals can come to school if masked.

We continue to ask you to consider having your child mask during this time of increased spread in the community.
