We currently have 6 positive students and 1 positive staff member. 13 students are quarantined at home for exposure outside of school. We also have 56 students and faculty/staff members who are "mask to stay" at this point in time. This means they have a known exposure, but are fully vaccinated or their exposure happened at school or CYO. This also includes individuals who previously tested positive and have completed their initial period of isolation. These individuals can come to school if masked.
