Our tuition for 2022-23 will be \$5,500 for Kindergarten Readiness through  $8^{th}$  grade. We also have a new fee structure for the upcoming year: The  $5^{th}$  grade fee will include the \$50 band class fee. The  $6^{th}$ ,  $7^{th}$  and  $8^{th}$  grade fee will include a standard gym uniform required for days the student has Phys Ed class.

We continue our commitment to making a St. Aloysius education affordable for your family. Please review the enclosed "Grant or Scholarship Opportunities" listing and contact me if you need further clarification.

Please contact me if your family does not qualify for a scholarship and there is a need for financial assistance. We will do our best to find a source of funds for your family.

## St. Aloysius Catholic School Registration Procedure

**Preschool Registration:** Preschool registration begins in January for our currently registered families. Registration opens for all families on a first come first serve basis beginning February 1, 2022. A commitment form and a \$100 commitment fee is required to secure your child's placement in the class.

**Kindergarten Readiness/Kindergarten Registration and Placement**: Registration for students in Kindergarten and Kindergarten Readiness will begin February 17<sup>th</sup> for current families. A completed registration packet and the Registration Fee & Classroom Materials Fee are to be returned by March 11, 2022. Upon receipt of a Kindergarten student's registration, the student will be placed in kindergarten or readiness. After screening in August 2022, a recommendation of placement into the Kindergarten Readiness or Kindergarten class will be decided by the Kindergarten Team (principal & teachers). If the educational team placement does not match the parent's initial registration request, further discussion will be initiated with the parents to determine what the best educational course is for the student. Registration for new families will begin March 28, 2022.

**Grade 1-8 Registration:** Registration for students in first through eighth grade will begin February 17, 2022 for current families. Completed student registration form, tuition registration form, Registration Fee, and Classroom Materials Fee are to be returned by March 11, 2022. Registration for new families will begin March 28, 2022. Admission to St. Aloysius Catholic School for new students will be determined by the Principal after reviewing previous school records. If after discussion with parents, admission is denied, the classroom fees will be refunded.

St. Aloysius Catholic School requires a solid commitment from parents to register and enroll their child(ren) for the 2022-2023 school year preferably by March 11th and no later than June 1, 2022. Various factors influence the school budget – enrollment, economy, state funding, parish subsidy, etc. In order to give the school appropriate time to study these factors and to budget effectively, we ask parents to make a final enrollment decision before summer break of 2022. Classes will be filled in the order in which the Registration packet and Registration/Materials Fees are returned. If the packet and/or fees are returned after the class is full, the student will be placed on a waiting list and payment will not be processed until a space becomes available.

\*\*\*With COVID-19 social distancing requirements currently in place, this may affect class size caps and create waiting lists more quickly than in previous years. \*\*\*

## 2022-23 Grant or Scholarship Opportunities

Please review the following and apply for the scholarship or grant that applies to your family.

#### **Multi-student Discount:**

+ PreK-8 Families with multiple children in school qualify for the multi-student grant: second child \$300; third child \$600; fourth child \$1,100. Indicate on the tuition registration form that you have more than one child registered.

#### Ed Choice Scholarships:

+ These scholarships from the state of Ohio provide up to \$5,500 per student per school year. They are open to K-8 families at a certain income level and/or to new students assigned to a specific public school building. State requirements have not been finalized for the coming school year so please let us know if you would like more information when it becomes available.

#### Jon Peterson Scholarship:

+ This is a state of Ohio scholarship open to K-8 students on an IEP. This scholarship will pay for services for the students and in some cases will pay for tuition. If your child is on an IEP, please contact the school office for more information.

#### Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund:

+ This is an independent scholarship opportunity for students K-8. The application deadline is April 30. Applicants must meet financial requirements and be drawn through a lottery to be awarded. If a family believes they may qualify, please refer to the flyer included for more information. Applications are completed online. The amount varies but typically \$500-\$2,000. #### **Parishioner Grant:**

+ Grant of up to \$2,400 per student available to Catholic parishioners who meet the following criteria: The family has at least one family member in the home who is Catholic and is registered with St. Aloysius Parish or a parish in the diocese that does not have a school. Through the use of time, talent and treasure the family helps support their parish. The family attends Mass. Submit application with registration form.

#### St. Aloysius School Grant:

+ Grant of up to \$500 per student available to families attending St. Aloysius School who do not qualify for the Parishioner grant or other scholarship opportunities. Submit application with registration form.

#### St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance:

+ Additional assistance available to families who have applied for all scholarships available to them but who need additional support to attend. Submit request with registration form.
