- **Tuition Assistance:** Beginning with the 2023-24 school year we will have a new process for tuition assistance. While different families will receive different assistance, it is not anticipated that any family would experience a large increase in their payments. Set tuition discounts (such as multi-student) and parish scholarships will be eliminated. Instead, all families not eligible for other scholarships or funding will complete a one-page tuition assistance form. Assistance will be provided based on the information on the application.

Christmas Program Details:

- Tuesday, December 13th will be our Christmas Program for Grades 4-8. We will have 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm performances. Students in grades 4-8 may wear festive holiday colors for their daytime performance (no jeans or athletic pants. Leggings must have a skirt over the top). This is a dress up day, but we encourage you to save their holiday best for the evening performances so they don't get dirty at lunch or recess. Students in Grades K-3 are expected to be in uniform on Tuesday.
- Band students should arrive between 6:15 and 6:45 for the evening program so they can get situated before the show.
- General music students should arrive at 6:45. If you arrive earlier than that to save seats, the students should stay with you in the gym until that time. They can not be wandering the building unsupervised. Thank you.

When I am notified that a student has been diagnosed with a contagious disease, I send out an email to the parents that have a child in that grade. Influenza A , influenza B and strep throat are the main illnesses going around the school right now. Sending me an email when your child has been diagnosed with anything contagious is much appreciated.

A student can return after being 24 hours fever free with no fever reducing medication. If a student vomits or has diarrhea they can return in 24 hours when they no longer have these symptoms.
