From the Principal:

Last week the registration packets for next year came home. As I shared in the fall we are using a new tuition assistance model and paperwork that will help us to maximize state scholarship funds. However, it is not our intent that anyone should have a larger than usual tuition increase. Please don't ever let finances dissuade you from choosing a Catholic education for your child.

A few reminders about tuition assistance:

- Tuition assistance is available to families who have applied for all scholarships available to them and need additional support to attend.
- Basic assistance of up to \$2,400 per student for parishioners (St. Aloysius, St. Thomas More or St. John XXIII grades K-8 or St. Louis, Custar grades 7-8) and up to \$500 per student for non-parishioners can be applied for using the Financial Form.
- Additional assistance can be applied for by submitting additional information as indicated on the Financial Form.
- We are asking each family to submit a Financial Form with their registration indicating what level of assistance they need or that they are not requesting assistance.
- No financial documentation is required with the application but we may request documentation to determine the award.

Please reach out to me with any questions or concerns or if you need help making decisions for your family for next year.

Tomorrow night is the first St. Al's "Cerealously, We're Building Rosaries" event and I hope you will consider attending with your children. Never made a rosary? Never prayed a rosary? No problem...this is a great chance to learn more about this devotion and meet some fellow parishioners. 

