From the Principal:

We recently signed up for the The Ohio Department of Education Afterschool Child Enrichment (ACE) program to assist our families with financial need to pay for the 8th grade trip to Washington, DC. The more I look at this program, the more impressed I am with the growing number of options so I wanted to make sure I share it with all of you. Currently, families at 300% of the poverty level or less can qualify for \$500 to use at a variety of camps and other enrichment programs. Starting April 7, current or newly qualifying families will receive a \$1,000 credit and also on that day the income guidelines will increase to 400% of the poverty level. I am attaching an income guideline to today's mailing so you can look to see if you qualify. If you do, please visit aceohio.org and see if there are opportunities that might be a good fit for your family whether it's tutoring, a summer camp or music or art lessons. Some programs require payment up front and the state will reimburse you, others will invoice the state directly. Families between 300% and 400% of the poverty level can enroll on or after April 7, 2023. I'm still figuring out some of the details myself, but am happy to try to answer questions you may have.
