A **new option** for families will be to add the materials fee to their FACTS payment plan. Monthly payments will be applied to the fees first then tuition.

**Another change** to the registration process is that we are asking every family to submit a financial form. On the one-page form each family may select: no assistance, basic assistance or other (fill in amount). This process replaces our discount system. Please see further information on page 4.

The process has changed but **our commitment** to making a St. Aloysius education affordable remains the same. It is the intent that families would have only a manageable increase in tuition after assistance is awarded.

# ***St. Aloysius Catholic School Registration Procedure***

**Preschool Registration:** Preschool registration begins in February for our currently registered families. Registration opens for all families on a first come first serve basis beginning in March. A commitment form and a \$100 registration fee is required to secure your child's placement in the class.

**Kindergarten Readiness/Kindergarten Registration and Placement:** Registration for students in Kindergarten and Kindergarten Readiness will begin February 23rd, 2023 for current families. A completed registration packet and the Registration Fee & Classroom Materials Fee are to be returned by March 16, 2023. Upon receipt of a Kindergarten student's registration, the student will be placed in kindergarten or readiness as indicated by the parent on the form. After screening in August 2023, a recommendation of placement into the Kindergarten Readiness or Kindergarten class will be decided by the Kindergarten Team (principal & teachers). If the educational team placement does not match the parent's initial registration request, further discussion will be initiated with the parents to determine what the best educational course is for the student. Registration for new families will begin March 27, 2023.

**Grade 1-8 Registration:** Registration for students in first through eighth grade will begin February 23rd, 2023 for current families. Completed student registration form, financial form, and registration fee are to be returned by March 16, 2023. Registration for new families will begin March 27, 2023. Admission to St. Aloysius Catholic School for new students will be determined by the Principal after reviewing previous school records. If after discussion with parents, admission is denied, the classroom fees will be refunded.

**St. Aloysius Catholic School requires a solid commitment from parents to register and enroll their child(ren) for the 2023-2024 school year preferably by March 16th and no later than June 1, 2023.** Various factors influence the school budget – enrollment, economy, state funding, parish subsidy, etc. In order to give the school appropriate time to study these factors and to budget effectively, we ask parents to make a final enrollment decision before summer break of 2023. Classes will be filled in the order in which the registration packet and fees are returned. If the packet and/or fees are returned after the class is full, the student will be placed on a waiting list and payment will not be processed until a space becomes available.

- Gr. 6-8 classroom materials fee: per student \$305  
*Includes elective fee and gym uniform*

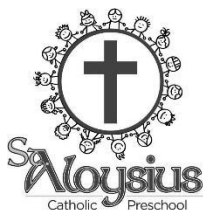

and 2 Full Days Tuesday/Thursday (9am-3pm)

- 3 year old: per student
  - 5 Half days: Monday through Friday (9-11:30 am) \$3120

  - 3 Half Days: Tuesday/Thursday/Friday (9am-11:30 am) \$2010

## **2023-2024 KR-8 Assistance or Scholarship Opportunities**

Please review the following and apply for the scholarship that applies to your family. **All families** should complete and submit the St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance Form.

### ***Ed Choice Scholarships:***

- These scholarships from the state of Ohio provide up to \$5,500 per student per school year. They are open to K-8 families at a certain income level and/or to new students assigned to a specific public school building. Income Eligibility guidelines are included in the registration materials.

### ***Jon Peterson Scholarship:***

- This is a state of Ohio scholarship open to K-8 students on an IEP. This scholarship will pay for services for the students and in some cases will pay for tuition. If your child is on an IEP, please contact the school office for more information.

### ***Northwest Ohio Scholarship Fund:***

- This is an independent scholarship opportunity for students K-8. The application deadline is April 28. Applicants must meet financial requirements and be drawn through a lottery to be awarded. If a family believes they may qualify, please review the Information available at <https://nosf.org>. Applications are completed online. The amount varies but typically \$500-\$2,000.

### ***St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance:***

- Tuition assistance is available to families who have applied for all scholarships available to them and need additional support to attend.
- Basic assistance of up to \$2,400 per student for parishioners (St. Aloysius, St. Thomas More or St. John XXIII grades K-8 or St. Louis, Custar grades 7-8) and up to \$500 per student for non-parishioners can be applied for using the Financial Form.
- Additional assistance can be applied for by submitting additional information as indicated on the Financial Form.
- We are asking each family to submit a Financial Form with their registration indicating what level of assistance they need or that they are not requesting assistance.
- No financial documentation is required with the application but we may request documentation to determine the award.
