From the Principal:

Thank you to all of you who helped with our Extended Day shortage this week and made other arrangements for their children. Everyone pitched in together and I can't tell you how much it is appreciated! We will be back at full strength next week, but will be looking to hire more for May.Help us spread the word, especially to any college students you know who may be returning to BG at that time.

IMPORTANT UPDATE

I also want to share an important update with you. In order to accommodate our upcoming construction project we are going to end the school year a couple days early and **our last day will be the Friday before Memorial Day, May 24th**. This will allow us some time to pack up several classrooms and be out of the way of the work crews coming in. 8th grade graduation will still be on May 29th as scheduled, but **kindergarten graduation will move to Thursday, May 23rd at 9am.** Thanks to a mild winter we have plenty of instructional hours for the year even with two less days.

We will also delay the start of the 24-25 school year and will have our **first day of school on Tuesday, September 3rd** after Labor Day. The longer summer will hopefully allow for the construction crew to get a great start on building our new entrance.

I hope these changes will not cause any issues for your family, but I promise that there will be many benefits of this project for our school and parish! Please let me know if you have any questions about this decision or the building plans..
