Kindergarten Readiness/Kindergarten Registration and Placement:

Upon receipt of a Kindergarten student's registration, the student will be placed in kindergarten or readiness. After screening in August 2024, a recommendation of placement into the Kindergarten Readiness or Kindergarten class will be decided by the Kindergarten Team (principal & teachers). If the educational team placement does not match the parent's initial registration request, further discussion will be initiated with the parents to determine what the best educational course is for the student.

2024-2025 KR-8 Scholarship Opportunities and Assistance

St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance for students in KR-8 is determined by family need after they have applied for and received scholarships for which they are eligible.

No tuition assistance is available for pre-school students.

EdChoice Scholarships:

+ All Ohio families are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship ranging from \$616 to \$6,166 depending on family income.

Special Needs Scholarships:

- + Jon Peterson scholarships are offered by the state of Ohio to K-8 students qualifying for an IEP (individualized education plan). This scholarship will pay for services for the students and in some cases will pay for tuition. If your child is on an IEP, please contact the school office for more information.
- + Ohio also awards Autism scholarships to K-8 students who qualify for services under an Autism diagnosis. This award usually covers tuition and services for the student.

St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance:

- + Tuition assistance is available to families who have applied for all scholarships available to them and need additional support to attend.
- Assistance for parishioners who have applied for EdChoice and receive a partial scholarship (\$616 to \$6,000) generally ranges from \$1,000 to \$2,200 per student. This applies to parishioners of St. Aloysius, St. Thomas More or St. John XXIII grades K-8 or St. Louis, Custar grades 7-8.
- + Assistance for non-parishioners and families who choose not to apply for EdChoice is generally \$100 to \$500 per student.
