We will be closed on Monday for the solar eclipse. Students will be bringing home their eclipse glasses today so please check their bookbags and pray for clear skies on Monday!

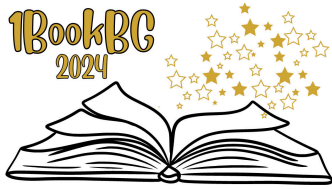
