From the Office:

- **BG busing** runs an alternate route on days that BGCS elementaries are not in session. NEXT Friday, 9/20, is the first alternate route. Car Line Reminders/Tips:

• There is room to load and unload three cars at a time. If you are the first car, please pull up all the way to the railing in front of the narthex doors.

- In the mornings, it is really helpful to have your kids unbuckled and things gathered while you are sitting in the line so they can exit quickly when your car pulls up to the steps.
- In the afternoons, if you need to buckle a younger child and it's not something that can be done quickly because of the placement of the car seat, please consider pulling off into the handicapped area to do that so the line can keep moving.

From the Nurse:

In Ohio, schools are required to contact a student's parent or guardian within 2 hours of the start of the school day if the student is absent. This is known as the Alianna Alert Law, named after Alianna DeFreeze who was abducted in 2017.

With the new school year it is a perfect time to send out some reminders. When a student is going to be absent or late coming to school, remember to notify the school office. This can be done by an email so you can cc any teachers and myself. (<u>nurse@stalschoolbg.org</u>) This is helpful if whoever was emailed happens to be out for the day. A phone call to the school office is fine as well.
