- Many of you know that we have confirmed cases of strep throat going around in most of the classrooms. Please monitor your child for signs and symptoms. If tested positive a student can return 24 hours after starting an antibiotic and have had 2 doses 12 hours apart. They need to be fever free without fever reducing medication for 24 hours.
- There is also a case of pneumonia and a couple of students with bronchitis.
- Vision and hearing testing has been completed. I will reach out to you if there are any concerns.
- Please make sure that your child has what they need to stay warm at recess.


## **From Parent Association:**
