If you would like to apply for a scholarship, please visit www.dotsgo.org This is a great opportunity for those who don't receive full Ed Choice scholarships to lower their tuition bill or you can make a request to cover fees that are not included in Ed Choice. If your child is on the Jon Peterson or Autism scholarship, you can apply for tuition funds so that more of the scholarship is available for services. Priority must be given to those with financial need, but you do not have to be low income to apply. Funds will be awarded by the end of 2024.


