From the Nurse:

I sent out an email to the classes that have confirmed cases of mycoplasma pneumonia. If your child is diagnosed they should stay home from school until the following criteria is met:

- They have been on an antibiotic for 24 hours.
- They feel well enough to return to school and their cough and other symptoms have improved.
- They are fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication. Vomiting and diarrhea free for 24 hours without medication.

Please remember to notify the school when your child is going to be absent. We need to be notified every day that your child is absent. If you email, it is helpful to add my email (nurse@stalschoolbg.org) just in case the person you are notifying is not here for the day. By law we have 2 hours from the start of the school day to account for any students not present.
