Cold and flu season has hit hard this year. Please keep your child home if they are not feeling well. Influenza A and B, strep throat and an intestinal virus are going around the school. The policy on returning to school is fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication. 24 hours after last vomiting or diarrhea without medication. Symptoms should have improved as well.

If your child is going to be absent or late, remember to notify the school with the reason. Symptoms are helpful to monitor what all is going around the school. In Ohio, schools are required to contact a student's parent or guardian if a student is absent and has not heard from the parent or guardian.

SGO FAQ (Answers to Common Questions about the Scholarship Granting Organization)

How do I know how much I owe (or paid) in state taxes so I know how much tax credit I can receive (up to the maximum allowed of \$750 per individual)?

On Form 1040 IT of your Individual Income Tax Return for the state of Ohio, reference line thirteen (13) or the Total Ohio tax Liability Line. For other tax-related questions, you are encouraged to consult a tax professional.

I read that the donation is non-refundable, what does that mean?
It means that once a gift is made, the SGO is unable to issue a refund to a donor. This term does not refer to the process of receiving a tax refund from the state
