#### **Kindergarten Readiness/Kindergarten Registration and Placement:**

Upon receipt of a Kindergarten student's registration, the student will be placed in kindergarten or readiness. After screening in August 2025, a recommendation of placement into the Kindergarten Readiness or Kindergarten class will be decided by the Kindergarten Team (principal & teachers). If the educational team placement does not match the parent's initial registration request, further discussion will be initiated with the parents to determine what the best educational course is for the student.

## **2025-2026 Tuition & Fees**

### **KR-8 Fees**

#### **Registration Fee due with registration (nonrefundable):**

- KR-8 per family – due with registration \$100
- KR-8 per family – **returning families after February 18** \$160

#### **Materials fee due by June 1 (Nonrefundable after June 1):**

- KR-4 classroom materials fee: per student \$245
- Gr 5 classroom materials fee per student \$295  
*Includes band class fee*
- Gr. 6-8 classroom materials fee: per student \$305  
*Includes elective fee and gym uniform*

- Kindergarten Readiness through Grade 8: per student \$6,500

## **2025-2026 Mustard Seed Foundation Scholarship**

The Mustard Seed Foundation Scholarship offers 3 types of scholarships ranging from \$500-\$1000 and is available to preschool families. Approximately 10 scholarships are awarded. This is the only available option for preschool tuition assistance. See the included flyer for more information.

## ***2025-2026 KR-8 Scholarship Opportunities and Assistance***

St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance for students in KR-8 is determined by family need after they have applied for and received scholarships for which they are eligible.

No tuition assistance is available for preschool students.

### ***EdChoice Scholarships:***

- + All Ohio families are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship depending on family income. The 24-25 amounts ranged from \$616 to \$6,166. The 25-26 amounts have not been released.

### ***Special Needs Scholarships:***

- + Jon Peterson scholarships are offered by the state of Ohio to K-8 students qualifying for an IEP (individualized education plan). This scholarship will pay for services for the students and in some cases will pay for tuition. If your child is on an IEP, please contact the school office for more information, [principal@stalschoolbg.org](mailto:principal@stalschoolbg.org).
- + Ohio also awards Autism scholarships to K-8 students who qualify for services under an Autism diagnosis. This award usually covers tuition and services for the student.

### ***Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO):***

- + Students may apply for a scholarship through the diocese of Toledo.
- + This scholarship comes from donations made to the Diocese of Toledo SGO. Donations can be made to the school.

- + Awards will vary based on the amounts available to the school through donations.

### ***St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance:***

- + Tuition assistance is available to families who have applied for all scholarships available to them (including the SGO) and need additional support to attend.
- + Tuition assistance is for parishioners who have applied for EdChoice and receive a partial scholarship. This applies to parishioners of St. Aloysius, St. Thomas More or St. John XXIII grades K-8 or St. Louis, Custar grades 7-8.
- + Assistance for non-parishioners and families who choose not to apply for EdChoice or the SGO is generally \$100 to \$500 per student.
