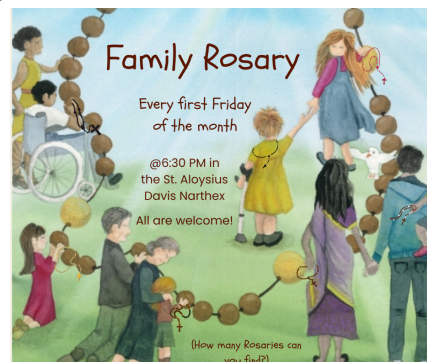
From the Office:
