### Dress Code Reminder:

As the new year gets underway it's helpful to clarify what sweatshirts are dress code and which are spirit wear. All dress code sweatshirts have either our current diamond shaped log on them or our old lion logo. These two logos or variations of them are on approved dress code items:

If the shirt says the word "LIONS" on it (even if it has our new lion logo replacing the letter O) or if it mentions a sports team it is not dress code. T-shirts are not dress code. Students are welcome to wear those as an outer layer at recess, but they shouldn't be worn during the school day. Also, remember that students participating in CYO sports may wear their team shirts/jerseys on Fridays during that sports season with their uniform bottoms. This means our CYO Cross Country and CYO Volleyball teams may wear their CYO tops tomorrow. If the shirt is sleeveless it needs to have a tshirt under it. Thank you for your cooperation.

### **From the Nurse:**

When your child is going to be absent or going to be late please notify the school office. Ohio has Alianna's law that requires all schools to contact parents or guardians within 2 hours from the start of school if not notified. If you would add me to any emails pertaining to a student being absent or tardy that would be helpful.

When any prescription medication needs to be given at school the form to give us permission will need to be filled out and signed by the doctor and parent. This includes eye drops. It is good to take this form with you to any appointments. All forms can be found on our website.

If your child has a fever they can return to school when fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication. If they are vomiting or have diarrhea they can return 24 hours after no more vomiting or diarrhea.

I will be starting vision and hearing screening in a couple of weeks. Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 5th and 7th grade and any new students will be tested. If you do not want your child tested please reach out to me by email.
