The St. Aloysius School Parent Association will be sponsoring their annual Mardi Gras Carnival on Tuesday, February 17th, 2026 in Hartmann Hall(gym). Each class will be allotted time for students to use their tickets to play games, win prizes, and get Mystery grab bags. Snacks and drinks will be provided. The proceeds from the Carnival will benefit our missions.

In order for this event to be successful for both our students and the missions, we are in need of your help. We are asking for donations of the following items:

-MYSTERY BAG/ RAFFLE PRIZES: small toys or puzzles that can fit in a paper lunch bag, candy bars, gift cards (Culver's, Five Below, Dairy Queen, Wendys) , etc.

-GAME PRIZES: snack size snack bags (chips, goldfish, etc.), cans of pop, candy, airheads, etc.

We ask that any monetary donations be sent to the school office in an envelope marked, "Mardi Gras donation." Raffle and game prize donations can be dropped off in the school office in the box marked "Mardi Gras."**

****PRESALE TICKETS** will start being sold Wednesday, January 28th and will run through Friday February 13th. Tickets are 25 cents each. Please send your money in an envelope **marked "Mardi Gras"** along with your **child's first and last name, grade** and the **amount enclosed to the school office no later than Friday, February 13th.** After February 13th, your child will need to stand in line the day of Mardi Gras to get his/her tickets. Generally, \$3 - \$5 is a good amount for the kids to play all the games. Presold tickets will be given to the students on the morning of Mardi Gras.

Parent Volunteers- an online sign up will be sent out January 22nd asking for snack donations and volunteers can sign up to help during the time of your child's class time slot or for the whole day. We also will need some helpers to set up on Monday and tear down right after event.
