Kindergarten Readiness/Kindergarten Registration and Placement:

Upon receipt of a Kindergarten student's registration, the student will be placed in kindergarten or readiness. After screening in August 2025, a recommendation of placement into the Kindergarten Readiness or Kindergarten class will be decided by the Kindergarten Team (principal & teachers). If the educational team placement does not match the parent's initial registration request, further discussion will be initiated with the parents to determine what the best educational course is for the student.

2026-2027 Mustard Seed Foundation Scholarship (Preschool Scholarship)

The Mustard Seed Foundation Scholarship offers 3 types of scholarships ranging from \$500-\$1000 and is available to preschool families. Approximately 10 scholarships are awarded. 2026-2027 KR-8 Scholarship Opportunities and Assistance

St. Aloysius Tuition Assistance for students in KR-8 is determined by family need after they have applied for and received scholarships for which they are eligible.

No tuition assistance is available for preschool students.

EdChoice Scholarships:

- + All Ohio families are now eligible for an EdChoice Scholarship depending on family income. The 25-26 amounts ranged from \$616 to \$6,166. The 26-27 amounts have not been released.

Special Needs Scholarships:

- + Jon Peterson scholarships are offered by the state of Ohio to K-8 students qualifying for an IEP (individualized education plan). This scholarship will pay for services for the students and in some cases will pay for tuition. If your child is on an IEP, please contact the school office for more information, principal@stalschoolbg.org.
- + Ohio also awards Autism scholarships to K-8 students who qualify for services under an Autism diagnosis. This award usually covers tuition and services for the student.

Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) and Parish Assistance:

- + Students may apply for the SGO and Parish Assistance during the registration process by completing the Tuition Registration Google form, <https://forms.gle/cGHAM1tCsB8Qdyn48>.
- + The SGO comes from donations made to the Diocese of Toledo SGO. Donations can be made to the school.
- + Awards for Parish Assistance and SGO will vary based on the amounts available to the school through donations.
- + Parish Assistance, subject to the availability of funds, is available to parishioners who have applied for all eligible scholarships (including SGO and EdChoice) and need additional financial support to attend St. Aloysius.
- + Parish Assistance for non-parishioners and families who choose not to apply for EdChoice or the SGO is generally \$100 to \$500 per student.
- + Those whose income falls below 200% of the FPL will not pay the remaining tuition balance and may request the SGO and/or Parish Assistance for the classroom materials & technology fee(s).
- + Those whose income falls between 200% and 450% of the FPL may request the SGO and/or Parish Assistance for the tuition balance and MAYBE classroom materials and technology fee(s). (Based on availability of funds.)
- + Those whose income is above 450% of the FPL may request the SGO or Parish Assistance for the TUITION BALANCE ONLY. (Based on availability of funds.)
