## From the Principal:

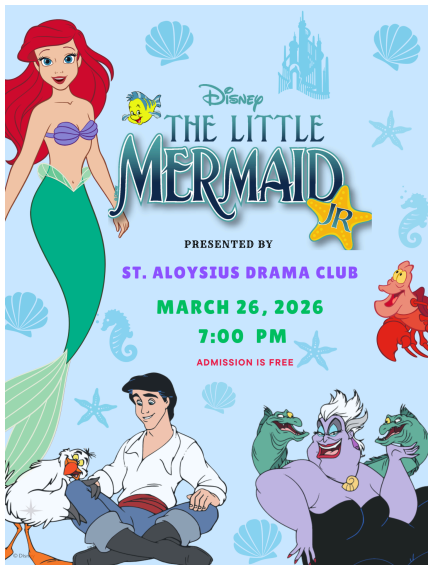
