Thank you all for your cooperation the first week of school! We love having your children here and they are off to a great start! I did want to share a few important reminders for car line as we all get into new routines:

- Please pull up close to the car in front of you so that we can fit more cars in each row. Once a row is filled completely, start the next row closer to the church. If when you arrive the last row closest to the church is filled in, please start again with a new row closest to the fence. That row will wait until the last row goes and then follow them to the half circle drive way.
- In the mornings, please have your child ready to exit the car when you reach the half circle drive way. If possible, get them unbuckled and say your goodbyes before you get to the front of the line. The cars behind you will be very appreciative. If you do need more time, please feel free to pull into a parking spot and walk them up.
- This is also a great time to teach younger children how to buckle themselves in their carseats or seatbelts to make dismissal go more smoothly. If they do need help, again feel free to load them in the car and then pull over into a spot to get them safely situated.
