Next week I will start vision and hearing screening. Some of the kindergarten students had this done during their physical and it will not need to be done again.

When a student needs any prescription medication to be given at school, a permission form needs to be included as well as a [physician request](#) form with signature. This is with any prescription medications. (eye drops, inhalers, oral meds etc) [Over the counter](#) medication has its own form that needs to be on file for any OTC meds to be given. These forms can be found on our website or can be picked up in the office.

When a student is going to be absent or late please let the school know as soon as possible. We are required by law to account for all students within 2 hours from the start of the school day. My email is nurse@stalschoolbg.org. You can always include me in your emails when notifying of an absence.

If anytime during the school year your child has surgery or visits a doctor for an injury, we will need a note with any restrictions and for how long. After a surgery a note with a return to school date is needed. Please let me know if you have any questions on this.
